



THE SMALLEST COUNTRY IN ASIA

The Maldives occupies the southern part of Asia, and it constitutes 26 atolls in the Indian Ocean. Its area is approximately 116 square miles, while the population is about 427,756. This territory has been subdivided into 21 administrative atolls, each of which is governed by an elected Atoll Council. Its administrative division oversees the activities of the capital Malé. The Maldives prides in a rich marine ecosystem which ranges from the shallow coast, fringing mangroves, deep sea, and reef ecosystems. Also present are 187 species of coral reefs and coral, 21 species of dolphins and whales, 1100 species of fish, 83 species of echinoderms, and 5 species of sea turtle. This ecosystem sustains a vibrant tourism industry.
