Rev. Raj Zackarias of the Catholic Bishops' Conference of India discusses the struggles of Dalit Christians, low-caste citizens ("untouchables") who comprise over 60% of India's 25 million Christians. The Indian constitution reserves places in educational institutions & government jobs for Dalits, but Christian & Muslim Dalits are denied such benefits because neither Christianity nor Islam recognize the caste system.
