

PAPER PRESENTATION FORMAT

Paper presenters will present their paper in a formal 10-15 minute presentation followed by a Q&A.

If your first choice format is a paper presentation, please prepare a submission that meets the following requirements:

- 1) Submit a paper (no more than 20 pages) and brief description, written for a Sociology class, course project, or with a faculty member (for example, independent study, internship, undergraduate research assistant program, McNair Scholars program etc.). Email paper and description to kstewa36@depaul.edu .
- 2) The paper should comply with the standards for the style in sociology (ASA style preferred). The paper should include an introduction to the topic or problem, analysis of literature, a description of methods and findings (if your work is empirical), and some discussion about the implications of your findings and/or significance of your contribution.
- 3) The paper needs to be about research and scholarship that has been completed.

All submissions will be reviewed by sociology faculty. The faculty reserve the right to decline the acceptance of submissions that do not meet the criteria above.
