#### Sr. Rosemary Nyirumbe, SSHJ


Named to TIME 100's "Most Influential" list in 2014 for her work in Uganda with the young victims of the Lord's Resistance Army (LRA)

Kenyan peacebuilder who works with warring ethnic groups in Sudan and northern Kenya, often putting her life at risk






#### Fr. Daniel F. Pilario, CM





### STATISTICAL SNAPSHOT

Since CWCIT was founded in 2008, we have



Held over 100 events, including an annual international conference at DePaul, with speakers representing nearly 60 different countries.



Hosted nearly 40 visiting research scholars, representing over 20 different countries.



Cohosted 7 overseas conferences (in the Philippines, Brazil, Nigeria, and Kenya), including the first-ever Pan African Catholic Congress in 2019.



Published 24 multi-author volumes, including one in Spanish and 3 in Portuguese.
