Registration for an upcoming term typically begins:

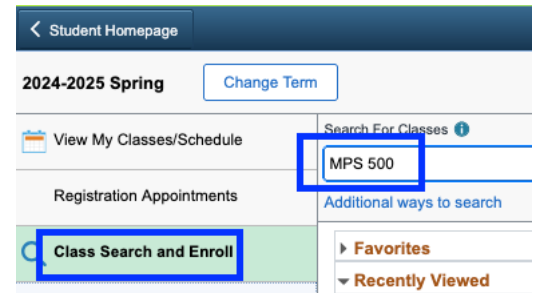
- Fall = early May
- Winter = mid October
- Spring = early February
- Summer = visible early February, register mid April

Check your “Registration Appointment” around the same time listed above to know the exact date/time you are eligible to enroll. This is located in Campus Connect, under Manage Classes. Each student is assigned a registration time per their class standing or student population (athlete, registered with OSD, etc.)

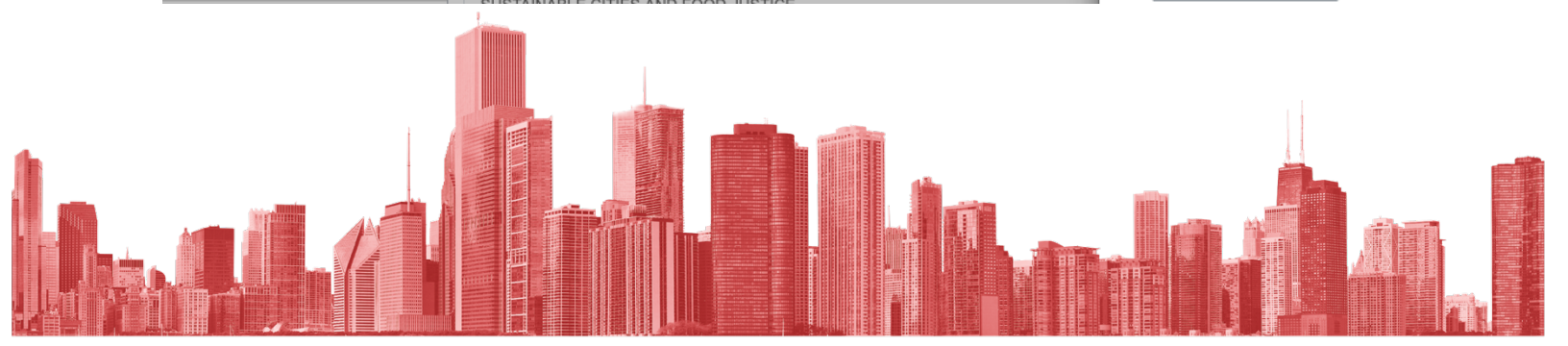
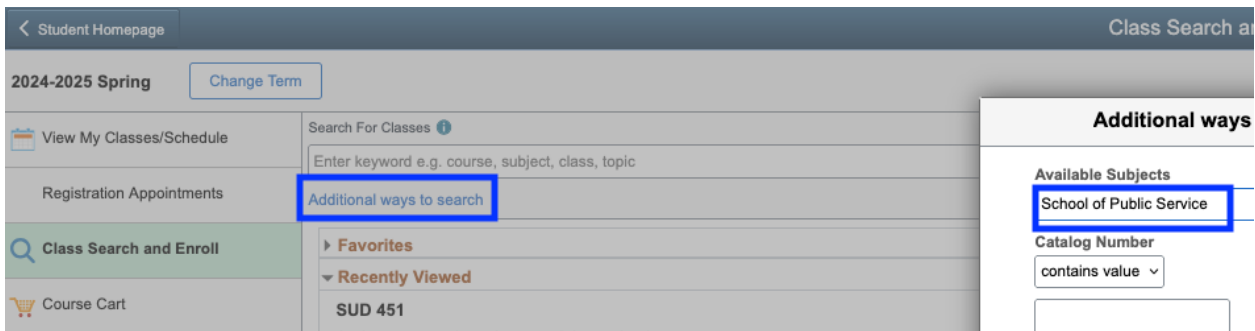


Find Classes

Pro Tips

1. Use the left-menu filters to help you refine your search.
2. Once you click on the course, notice the posted units (i.e., credits). **Tuition billing is based on the number of credits for which you register.**
3. Click on **“Course Information”** to read the course description.
4. Click on the class hyperlink to confirm your eligibility to enroll in the course (prerequisites & enrollment restrictions)
5. Click anywhere in the course box BUT the hyperlink and follow the prompts on the upper right corner to register

Waitlisting

1. Click “add to waitlist if class if full” just in case the course becomes waitlisted before you’re able to register.
2. You’ll receive notification of your waitlist position after you complete the registration steps, but you’ll also know based on the stated # of available waitlist seats (e.g., 8 of 9 seats available = 1 person already on waitlist = you’ll be #2)
3. If you want a back-up course, register for your back-up course FIRST. Then click Swap Classes, select your back-up course from the top option, and then click search/find your preferred course and “swap” into your preferred course.
 - **Without this, you run the risk of NOT getting off of the waitlist.**
 - a. There is no confirming your registration into a waitlisted course. This is first come, first serve. If you’re #2 on the waitlist, you’ll need to wait for 2 students to choose to drop the course. The add-a-class deadline still applies. The more time between the add class deadline, the more likely you may be added to the class (more chance some of your peers may drop).
